





# SURGICAL GASTROENTEROLOGY

The Department of Surgical Gastroenterology and Liver Transplantation at Osmania Medical college, Hyderabad established in 2010. This is the only SGE Department in entire Telangana state government sector hospitals providing complex supra major GI surgeries and organ transplantation services to poor with free of cost.

Performed more than 5000 supra major complex surgeries and 40 liver transplantations (both cadaver and living donor liver transplantations) till now. Also done advanced Laparoscopic surgeries for oesophagus, liver ,pancreas, biliary, ,gastric ,colorectal, bariatric patients. The department also provides MCh (SGE) super speciality PG courses in this department.

### Awards / Achievements/ Conferences:

- The department has done 40 liver transplantation surgeries till now in those 23 cases are Cadaver liver transplantation and 17 cases are Living Donor Liver Transplantation.
- Did liver transplantation for the smallest baby (6weeks) suffering with rare disease (Abernethy's malformations).
- Did first Combined Pancreas and kidney Transplantation in Telangana state for 27 yr. male, Type I Diabetic patient with kidney failure at Osmania General Hospital, Hyderabad
- DOEGY POTTERY SYNDROME: A rare cause of Hypoglycemia caused by Insulin like Growth factor produced by solitary fibrous tumour of liver. Successfully cured and this is the first case documented in India.
- Successfully operated upon world largest gallbladder cancer.

Reconstructive surgeries include postburn contracture (PBC) release with skin grafting, palatal fistula repair, vaginoplasty, faciomaxillary trauma management, and TMJ ankylosis correction. Additional expertise encompasses eyelid reconstruction, ectropion correction, tendon and nerve grafting, and flap coverage for complex limb contractures.
